<p>I can't find information about Social Prescribing offerings in South Derbyshire.</p>	<p>Thank you for your feedback. South Derbyshire is covered by Derby City.</p> <p>Social prescribing in Derbyshire and Derby City is delivered primarily through GP practices and Primary Care Networks (PCNs), which employ Social Prescribing Link Workers across the county. Although South Derbyshire isn't listed as a standalone service area, the county hosts around 87 social prescribing link workers distributed across Derby and Derbyshire.</p> <p>If you are registered with a South Derbyshire GP, you can be referred to a link worker who will connect you to local community, wellbeing, housing, finance, or social support options.</p> <p>To view a list of organisations that your GP can refer you to as part of Social Prescribing, please visit: Joined Up Care Derbyshire.</p>	<p>30/09/2025</p>
