FREE Governor Training:

The Inclusion Support Advisory Service (ISAS) are delivering a session tailored for governors to provide them with an introduction to autism and the reasonable adjustments that need to be considered when working with autistic pupils and supported autistic staff.

The Aims:

- To help Governors to approach autism as a difference rather than as a deficit or disorder
- To extend your understanding of how autism affects pupils & staff in school
- To recognise the three areas of difference for autistic pupils and staff, and how these can affect their mental and physical health, their access to social, and academic learning opportunities
- To listen to, and learn from the perspectives of autistic pupils and their parents/carers
- To consider the role of governors in ensuring that pupils and staff are supported successfully
- To look at the role of governors in ensuring that barriers to learning for autistic pupils are identified and reduced
- To develop your understanding of what "reasonable adjustments" means so that you are able to support autistic pupils and staff in your setting.
